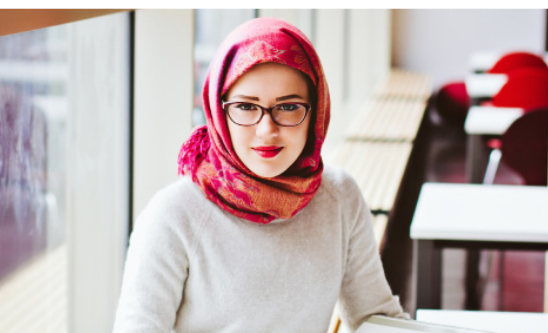


ENGLISH ACADEMIC PREPARATION (EAP)
